TRIST02 Turkey's Most Amazing Edifices

Explore the "Blue Mosque" and Topkapi Palace -- Visit three of Istanbul's most impressive and legendary landmarks on this awe-inspiring excursion. At the iconic Sultan Ahmed Mosque, or "Blue Mosque," you can marvel at slender minarets and a cascade of domes, one of Istanbul's most recognizable sights. With your guide, explore its lavish interior, decorated with the blue Iznik tiles that give the building its nickname. Visit the huge fortified complex of Topkapi Palace to glimpse the lives of sultans. Once the epicenter of the Ottoman Empire, it is now home to spectacular treasures. Walk through the gardens and see some of the historic riches on display. You will also browse the largest covered market in the world, the Grand Bazaar, whose narrow passageways play host to more than 3,000 cafés and shops. At one of its carpet shops, you can see how Turkish carpets are made. You will have time for shopping before returning to your ship. Please note: On Sundays, a part of the Grand Bazaar is closed.

TRIST16 Istanbul Cityscape

Old City Walls, Spice Market and Rüstem Pasha Mosque -- Journey into the heart of Istanbul, visiting a beautifully tiled, seldom-seen mosque and the bustling Spice Bazaar. Join your guide for a scenic drive along the ancient Walls of Constantinople, a UNESCO World Heritage Site containing portions that date from the 4th century. You will stop at the Rüstem Pasha Mosque, built in 1561. This is one of the city's hidden treasures, often ignored in favor of the "Blue Mosque" that towers beside it. Inside, you will find exquisitely colored Iznik tiles of blue, red, green and purple covering the entrance, the pulpit (minbar) and its columns. This is the most richly tiled mosque in Istanbul; its facade is similarly decorated. Then, travel to the famous Spice Bazaar, where its mix of colors and scents will enchant your senses as you explore the vendor stalls and take time to mingle with locals shopping for exotic spices. After, return to your ship.

TRIST03 Panoramic Istanbul

An Introduction to the Beauty of Istanbul -- Explore the Asian and European sides of Istanbul on this panoramic drive and enriching tour. You will enjoy breathtaking vistas at every turn. On the European side of the strait, visit the magnificent Hagia Sophia, built as a cathedral and later converted into a mosque. At the Grand Bazaar, the largest covered market in the world, explore narrow passageways lined with more than 3,000 cafés and shops. Visit one shopkeeper to see how his richly decorated Turkish carpets are made. After some free time for shopping among the bazaar's many colorful stalls, return to your ship.

Bosphorus Cruise, Beyazit Mosque & Sahaflar Çarsisi -- Admire Istanbul from the waters of the Bosphorus Strait and explore two of its cultural landmarks. Meet your guide and set off on foot along the bustling banks of the Bosphorus Strait en route to boarding a local sightseeing boat for a scenic cruise along this historic waterway that separates two continents. Sail past traditional wooden villas, 19th-century Ottoman palaces and Rumeli Fortress, a medieval hilltop fortification. Stop for a delicious Turkish-style breakfast on shore before continuing your cruise. Later, disembark your boat in the port of Eminönü and transfer to the historic Beyazit Mosque, a beautiful example of Ottoman architecture. Cap your tour at the Sahaflar Çarsisi, a renowned secondhand book market. Enjoy time browsing this haven for book lovers, among a treasure trove of old texts and manuscripts, before returning to your ship.

Explore its collection of calligraphy, illuminated manuscripts, intricately designed ceramics, extravagant textiles and exquisite jewelry. Admire the museum's halls adorned with masterful geometric patterns, vibrant tiles and intricate arabesques that reflect Turkey's cultural heritage. After, journey into the world of Ebru, the traditional Turkish art of paper marbling and listed as a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage. You will receive an introduction on how to select colors and create intricate designs in water before transferring them onto paper. Then, follow the guidance of a knowledgeable artisan as you create your own artwork as a memento.

Follow your nose to the famous Spice Bazaar and take time to mingle with locals shopping for colorful exotic spices. You will also savor an unforgettable spa treatment at a traditional hammam. Leave your belongings in a locker, don a traditional cotton wrap and step into your male or female steam room. There, you will stretch out on a warm marble table and an attendant will exfoliate your skin, smother you in bubbles and escort you to a soaking bath dressed in a sarong.

During your visit, you will be entranced by the sounds of the sultans as Ottoman rhythms transport you to the golden era of the Ottoman Empire. You will return to your ship in time for dinner on board.

Witness Istanbul's Grand Sights After Dark -- Experience Istanbul, the city where "East meets West," in all its illuminated glory during a scenic drive and walk. In the heart of the Old Town, cross the Galata Bridge and view the Sea Walls of Constantinople, the city's defensive stone walls that have protected Istanbul since the 4th century, running from the Sea of Marmara to the Golden Horn. Continue on foot, admiring the towering domes and minarets of the "Blue Mosque," named after its ornate blue-color tiled interior. Pause for photos and head to the Hippodrome of Constantinople; now a tranquil park, it was once the social hub of the city, hosting horse and chariot racing. Cap your time here with views of the facade of the majestic Hagia Sophia, considered the world's finest example of Byzantine architecture. Then, return to your ship via motor coach.
