Google Maps is excellent to use for navigation

9:00 AM: Wander the park

The early morning is one of the best times to enjoy the park while its relatively empty, stroll, enjoy the sights, sounds and greenery.

9:50 AM: National Museum of Anthropology

The best time to go is right when it opens (10:00 AM). This gives you several hours to peruse the various exhibition spaces and to do deep dives into areas



1:00 PM: National Museum of Anthropology

The museum has a restaurant, which I highly recommend. It's both delicious and convenient. Make sure to make a reservation or go when it opens at 1:00 PM.

2:30 PM: Musem Rufino Tamayo

This museum houses modern and contemporary art and is the smaller of the two art museums.

Pairs nicely with the Anthropology Museum which is also a close wal.k





Chapultepec Park in Two Days Day 2

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9:00 AM: Altar a la Patria Monument that honors six teenage military cadets who died defending Mexico during the U.S. invasion of 1847.

9:50 AM: Chapultepec Castle

The best time to go is right when it opens (10:00 AM). Make sure to wear very comfortable shoes, the walk to the castle is ALL uphill! Be sure to also tour the gardens and the personal living quarters!



12:30 PM: Lunch in the Park

The park features various "restaurant zones" (follow park signs), which are lined with rows of food stalls selling traditional Mexican street food. For an authentic experience, don't miss out! Afterwards, wander bit and check the market stalls selling souvenirs

2:00 PM: Museum of Modern Art

This is the larger and more glamorous art museum in Chapultepec and houses some of Mexico's most well known masterpieces. Also check out the sculpture garden which is quite extensive. Enjoy its peaceful, serene nature!
